




O R D E RIA No. 30109/2019

This application is preferred on behalf of the students who are admitted to the Sakshi Medical College under the order of this Court, dated 03.10.2016. This Court specifically directed that the students should be admitted without insisting on 'domicile'. It appears that the essentiality certificate of the college was withdrawn by the State

Government. Therefore, the need for reallocating the students has arisen. The State Government proposes to reallocate students into different colleges in the State. However, it seems that now they are insisting on the requirement of 'domicile' for the purposes of reallocation which involves admission to other colleges.

Having heard both the parties, we are of the view that the criterion adopted while admitting the these students, i.e., without insisting on 'domicile', cannot be altered while reallocating the students to other colleges. Circular dated 06.11.2018 provides for reallocation of these students on the basis of the result in the 'NEET' examination. This does not by itself mean that there should be an insistence on domicility that is sought to be included by some guidelines of 15.02.2019.

Order dated 5.10.2016 has been brought to our notice. There is nothing in the order which reverses the direction in the earlier order to the effect that the students shall be admitted without insisting on domicile certificate.

Having regard to the circumstances, we direct that the students who are reallocated from the Sakshi Medical College on account of withdrawal of essentiality certificate will be so reallocated without insistence of domicility as originally ordered by this Court on 03.10.2016.

I.A. No. 30109/2019 is disposed of accordingly.
