The Eligibility of candidates for Stray Vacancy Round of UG Counselling to be conducted by MCC and State Counselling may be noted as under:

- Candidates who are not holding any seat either in All India Quota or State Quota are eligible to participate in Stray Vacancy Round of UG Counselling 2024 to be conducted by MCC.
- Candidates who did not join their seats allotted through MCC in Round-3 are 'Not Eligible' to participate in Stray Vacancy Round of UG Counselling 2024. However, 'Not Reported' candidates of Round-3 of MCC counselling can participate in state UG counselling.
- Candidates who have joined State quota seats through earlier Rounds are not eligible to participate in Stray Vacancy Round of UG Counselling 2024.
- The Security Deposit of candidates who do not join their allotted seat in Stray Vacancy Round will be forfeited and such candidates will be debarred from taking NEET exam for the next year.
- The data of JOINED CANDIDATES of stray vacancy round conducted by MCC will be shared with states and candidates who are allotted seats by MCC and have joined the allotted seats will be debarred from taking admission in state counselling.
